ATTENTION TEACHING/NON-TEACHING STAFF, STUDENTS/SCHOLARS AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS

1. All the students/scholars shall park their vehicles at designated parking slots at Sir Syed Gate, Moulana Rumi Gate and Zainul Abidin Gate. However, specially-abled students may be allowed to take their vehicles to their respective departments after seeking proper permission from the Office of the Chief Proctor.
2. The teaching and non-teaching staff shall park their vehicles displaying valid stickers at designated parking slots near their respective Departments/Offices. It would be highly appreciated if they refrain from using their vehicles for internal movement within the campus.
3. The contractors, suppliers, shopkeepers and other visitors/guests shall park their vehicles in the above mentioned parking slots. The contractors/suppliers shall seek a special permission from the Office of the Chief Proctor for taking their vehicles inside the campus for the delivery of the items only as and when required.
4. The hostel boarders shall keep their vehicles parked near their respective hostels. They shall refrain from plying their vehicles in the campus except in case of extreme emergency after seeking the permission from the Office of the Chief Proctor.
5. The Zainul Abidin Gate will remain open exclusively for parking purposes only on the working days from 9:00 a.m to 11:00 a.m in the morning and 3:30 p.m to 5:30 p.m in the evening. The gate shall remain close for the entry and exit of the vehicles from 11:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. to 9:00 a.m.
 - The parking stickers and vehicle entry passes can be had from the Office of the Chief Proctor in due course of time. Till then already issued vehicle passes shall remain valid.
 - The violation of any kind may result in imposition of fine and/or confiscation of the vehicle.
 - These instructions shall be implemented w.e.f. 01-08-2018.
